

## **RESOLUTION AWARDING THE “CARLOS V EUROPEAN AWARD-EUROPEAN DISABILITY FORUM” EUROPEAN RESEARCH AND MOBILITY GRANTS FOR EUROPEAN STUDIES**

IN VIEW OF the final proposed resolution of 20 November 2025 issued by the managing director of the European and Ibero-American Academy of Yuste Foundation, acting as the instructing body for the procedure launched by the Announcement of 30 July 2025, which published the Call for Applications for the “Carlos V European Award-European Disability Forum” European Research and Mobility Grants for European Studies (DOE No. 150, of 5 August 2025) and based on the following,

### **STATEMENTS OF FACT**

**FIRST.-** On 14 May 2018, Decree 54/2018 of 8 May was published in the Official Journal of Extremadura, issue no. 92, approving the regulatory bases for the “Carlos V European Award” European Research and Mobility Grants for European Studies of the European and Ibero-American Academy of Yuste Foundation.

**SECOND.-** On 5 August 2025, the Announcement of 30 July 2025 announcing the Call for Applications for the “Carlos V European Award-European Disability Forum” European Research and Mobility Grants for European Studies of the European and Ibero-American Academy of Yuste Foundation was published in D.O.E. No. 150 and disseminated via its website ([www.fundacionyuste.org](http://www.fundacionyuste.org)).

**THIRD.-** Once the corresponding procedure had been carried out in accordance with the provisions of the seventh basis of the call, the applications submitted had been assessed, and the jury’s report issued, the managing director of the European and Ibero-American Academy of Yuste Foundation drew up a proposed resolution dated 20 November 2025.

**FOURTH.-** On 24 November 2025, the General Secretariat of the Regional Ministry of Presidency, Home Affairs and Social Dialogue of the Regional Government of Extremadura issued authorisation to continue processing the grants and proceed to their award in accordance with the regulatory bases and the call for applications.

### **LEGAL GROUNDS**

**FIRST.-** The competence to issue the resolution awarding these grants lies with the president of the Executive Commission of the Foundation, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 8 of the seventh basis of the call, which states that:

“The resolution of the granting procedure corresponds to the person holding the presidency of the Executive Committee of the Foundation, following authorisation from the General Secretariat of the Regional Ministry of Presidency, Home Affairs, and Social Dialogue of the Regional Government of Extremadura to proceed with the processing of the grants and grant them in accordance with the regulatory bases and this call”.

**SECOND.-** The procedure for awarding the grants established in this call is competitive and open to public application, in accordance with the provisions of the fourth basis of the said call and the seventh regulatory basis approved by Decree 54/2018 of 8 May.

**THIRD.-** In accordance with the provisions of paragraph 4 of the sixth basis of the call, the deadline for submitting applications runs from the day following the publication of the call announcement and its extract in the Official Journal of Extremadura until 19 September 2025.

**FOURTH.-** Once the corresponding procedure has been carried out in accordance with the provisions of the seventh basis of the call, the instructing body, in view of the file and the jury's assessment, drew up a proposed final resolution awarding the grants, including a list of beneficiaries and a separate list of substitute applicants.

In view of the foregoing, and in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 8 of the seventh basis of the call,

### **I HEREBY DECIDE**

**FIRST.** – To award the “Carlos V European Award-European Disability Forum” European Research and Mobility Grants for European Studies to the applicants listed in Annex I, for a total amount of TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND EUROS (€25,000), at a rate of TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED EUROS (€2,500) per beneficiary, to be paid from the Foundation's 2025 budget.

**SECOND.** – To establish a waiting list with the applicants listed in Annex II, with the aim of acquiring beneficiary status in the event of withdrawals, failure to fulfil obligations, supervening incapacity, or any other cause leading to the loss of beneficiary status by any of the individuals listed in Annex I, and which occurs after the publication of the resolution.

**THIRD.** - Grant a period of five working days, counting from the day following the date of notification, for the grant recipients to communicate their acceptance in accordance with the model set out in Annex IV. Otherwise, in accordance with paragraph twelve of the seventh basis of the call, it shall be understood that the recipient has tacitly renounced the awarded grant.

**FOURTH.-** The grant recipients are obliged to comply with the obligations generally established in Article 13 of Law 6/2011 of 23 March, and, in particular, those set out in the ninth basis of the call, within the deadlines specified therein.

**FIFTH.-** Publish this Resolution on the website of the European and Ibero-American Academy of Yuste Foundation.

An appeal against this resolution may be lodged with the Secretary General of the Regional Ministry of the Presidency, Home Affairs and Social Dialogue of the Regional Government of Extremadura within one month from the day following the date of notification of the act, without prejudice to the right of the interested parties to exercise any other remedy they deem appropriate.
