

RESOLUTION AWARDING THE “CARLOS V EUROPEAN AWARD - ANTÓNIO GUTERRES” EUROPEAN RESEARCH AND MOBILITY GRANTS IN EUROPEAN STUDIES

IN VIEW OF the Proposal for a Final Decision dated 29 May 2026, submitted by the managing director of the European and Ibero-American Academy of Yuste Foundation, and the prior authorisation granted by the secretary-general of the Regional Ministry responsible for the European and Ibero-American Academy of Yuste Foundation to the person holding the Presidency of its Executive Committee to continue the processing of the grants and proceed with their award, all in accordance with the provisions of the seventh base of the ANNOUNCEMENT of 4 February 2026, announcing the call for applications for the “Carlos V European Award – António Guterres European Research and Mobility Grants in European Studies” (Official Journal of Extremadura (DOE) No. 28, 11 February 2026).

I HEREBY DECIDE

FIRST.- To award the “Carlos V European Award – António Guterres” European Research and Mobility Grants in European Studies to the persons listed in Annex I, for a total amount of TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND EUROS (€25,000), at a rate of TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED EUROS (€2,500) per beneficiary, to be charged to the Foundation’s 2026 budget.

SECOND.- To establish a reserve list comprising the persons listed in Annex II (alternates), for the purpose of acquiring beneficiary status in the event of resignation, breach of obligations, subsequent incapacity, or any other circumstance entailing the loss of beneficiary status by any of the persons listed in Annex I, occurring after the publication of this decision.

THIRD.- To grant a period of **five working days**, commencing on the day following notification, for the beneficiaries of these grants to communicate their **acceptance** (Annex IV).

FOURTH.- The grant recipients must comply with the obligations set out in point 1 of the ninth base of the ANNOUNCEMENT of 4 February 2026, announcing the call for applications for the “Carlos V European Award – António Guterres European Research and Mobility Grants in European Studies” (Official Journal of Extremadura (DOE) No. 28, 11 February 2026).

FIFTH.- This decision may be appealed before the secretary-general for the Presidency, Home Affairs and Social Dialogue of the Regional Government of Extremadura within a period of one month from the day following notification of the act, without prejudice to any other remedy that the interested parties may deem appropriate.

SIXTH.- To publish this Decision on the website of the European and Ibero-American Academy of Yuste Foundation.
